Tournament Rules

- 1. Eligibility and team makeup is subject to the rules stated on the Bowler Information form. Everyone who participates and guests will be members of the AABA without charge. All participants must be age 18 or older.
- 2. Bowlers may enter as often as they wish. The same regular doubles or 4-person team may cash only once on the main prize list. Regular Doubles team must have at least **one** different bowler. 4-Person team must have at least **one** different bowler.
- 3. All entries will be scheduled in the order they are received. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to assign bowlers to another squad if the entrant's choice is full.
- 4. All bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled squad time. An entrant must report any substitute to the Tournament Committee 60 minutes before they are scheduled to bowl. Substitutes must bowl in the position of the person being replaced.
- 5. Any bowler(s) arriving late shall receive a zero score for all frames missed. Actual scores to count from the frames being bowled. Entry fee will NOT be refunded.
- 6. Averages for all bowlers will be retrieved from the USBC website bowl.com. All bowlers must provide their USBC ID on the Bowler Information form. If the average as listed on bowl.com is inaccurate, it is the bowler's responsibility to provide the correct average on a form signed by their Association Secretary or Officer.
- 7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-rate or reject a bowler any time prior to bowling.
- 8. A bowler who has won or is in a position to win **\$600** or more in any tournament within the past 12 months must report actual scores, position, and earnings to the Tournament Committee prior to bowling. Failure to report **could** result in disgualification with **no** refund of entry fees.
- 9. Tournament entering average (21 or more games) shall be the highest of A or B. If no average can be found, E will apply.
- A. 2022 2023 USBC Winter league book average (5/31/2023)
- B. 2021 2022 USBC Winter league book average (5/31/2022)
- C. If not A or B, but bowling Summer 2023, please provide estimated average and submit end of summer league sheet to the tournament committee at check in.
- D. If not A, B, or C, please provide last known average and year.
- E. If no average found, then the bowler will use 220 as their entering average.

Following will be considered in determining a bowler's tournament entering average.

- 1. If bowler has a Challenge/Sport league average for a year, it will be adjusted according to USBC Challenge/Sport Average table.
- 2. Non USBC certified league averages.
- 3. AABA/Reno Asian 3 year tournament average may be used if it is higher than any average in section 9.
- 10. If a bowler has had an average rerate above the average specified in rule 9, it must be reported to the tournament committee prior to bowling. Failure to report **could** result in disqualification with **no** refund of entry fees.
- 11. Men's handicap shall be 80% of 220 with a maximum of 64 pins per game. Women's handicap shall be 90% of 220 with a maximum of 90 pins per game.
- 12. All fully paid entries will be scheduled in the order they are received. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to assign bowlers to another squad
- if the requested squad is full. Entries not paid or partially paid will not be scheduled until full payment is received.
- 13. Any doubles or 4 person team consisting of all seniors (age 60 and up) will be placed into Senior Doubles and Senior Team prize funds. Age 60 as of 8/25/2023.
- 14. Any bowler withdrawing from a squad or squads after the start of the first squad of the tournament will not receive any refund of entry fees.
- 15. Before any prize distribution, the tournament committee will re-verify all averages. All prize funds returned 100%. Prize fund ratio shall be at least 1 to 8.
- 16. Any protest must be made in writing prior to the issuance of tournament prize payments. Should any dispute arise, the decisions of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
- 17. Bowling Ball: After a bowler begins competition in a squad, no adjustments to the bowling ball surface will be allowed. Ball surface can be cleaned with a dry towel only.
- 18. Bowling Shoes: No substance, including talcum powder or EZ Slide, can be applied to a player's shoes.

- 2. Normal AABA eligibility rules are waived for the No-Tap tournament, anyone can bowl with anyone.
- 3. If you get at least 9 pins on your first ball in each frame, it will be scored a strike.
- 4. Separate prize fund from regular tournament.
- 5. If both bowlers are Senior (age 60 and up), team will be in the Senior No-Tap Divison prize fund
- 6. \$60 Team Entry fee: \$33.00 to prize fund, \$27.00 to lineage and expenses.
- 7. Late or absent bowlers get zero score for each frame missed. No refund for absent bowlers.
- 8. Please check in by 4:30 PM.
- 9. All other situations to be covered by general tournament or USBC rules.
